The FHWC provides traditional and mainstream therapeutic and healing services to our families and children in a residential program setting to promote healthy family dynamics to prevent family breakdown and facilitate successful family reunifications.

The Manager will oversee the FHWC staff to develop, implement, and improve the program curriculum and services provided to the children and families accessing the FHWC program and be in regular communication with the Agency and communities served to ensure the FHWC is meeting the needs of the Southeast community members.

### **Qualifications**

- Post-secondary diploma or degree in the social services field or an equivalent combination of education and experience
- Minimum of five (5) years in a supervisory or managerial role in a social services workplace
- Experience gathering and analyzing information to implement appropriate actions
- Demonstrated working knowledge of and familiarity with
  - Indigenous culture and an appreciation of rural and remote First Nation social issues and environment
  - *An Act respecting First Nations, Inuit and Métis children, youth and families; The Child and Family Services Act*; Indigenous child welfare practices; First Nations history, and colonization
  - Crisis intervention, child protection services, prevention services
  - Substance abuse, family violence, child abuse/neglect, grief and loss issues, and trauma
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills including documentation and report-writing
- Ability to travel and reside at the FHWC lodge 2-3 weeks per month
- A valid driver's license and reliable vehicle
- Proficiency with research, internet, and Microsoft Office
